

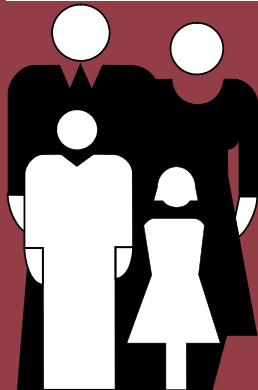
Domestic Mediation Training

This training focuses on application of the mediation process to situations involving divorced or separating parents who cannot agree on issues related to child custody and parenting.

Topics include...

- ◆ Divorce as family reorganization
- ◆ Impact of divorce on children
- ◆ Developmentally appropriate parenting plans
- ◆ Working with high conflict families
- ◆ Assessing for domestic violence and abuse
- ◆ Kansas divorce and mediation law

Prerequisite: Core-level mediation training; completion of core co-mediators is not required.
